Re: Measuring Broadband American Program, GN Docket No. 12-264

Dear Ms. Dortch:

On March 28, 2013, representatives of broadband providers, public interest groups, companies, and other organizations met via conference call with Commission staff to discuss the Commission's broadband measurement and performance program for broadband performance on mobile handsets. The meeting agenda was focused on soliciting feedback and answering questions regarding the general beta release of the FCC's mobile performance measurement Android application released on March 20, 2013.¹

James Miller, Senior Attorney Advisor Electromagnetic Compatibility Division (EMCD), opened the meeting discussing feedback received from Jim Warner, USCD, that the background grid of the application and scaling of fonts sizes made viewing difficult on 7 inch tablet screens. He also suggested reorganization of the passive metric fields in the archived tests screens.

Mr. Miller discussed a signature copy of the 2013 Mobile Stakeholders Code of Conduct circulated with participants and indicated signed copies of the documents would be welcome after April 4, 2013. Participants inquired when the Android application might be released to the general public. Mr. Miller explained that wireless carriers were reviewing the application to identify potential issues and concerns, and feedback on the current build of the application was expected in early April with a broader beta testing by wireless carriers to follow. Mr. Walter Johnston, Chief EMCD, indicated that depending on feedback received and based on current schedules, beta testing may conclude in the late May or early June time frame, and that a general release would follow the conclusion the of beta testing efforts.

Mr. Miller thanked the participants for their participation and support of the beta testing effort, and invited participants to attend an upcoming mobile collaborative meeting to be announced on the mailing list in the coming weeks.
