

I talked with officer Natiwa and officer Jary after attempting to submit an ECFS filing today from the Denny's next to the LaQuinta at 2424 San Mateo N.E. in Albuquerque N.M.. The Denny's is the same Denny's that I called the 415 (or 405) 12th street number on the last Friday of October in 2011 at 5:15 regarding the off route driving of Albuquerque bus 712 (if I remember correctly). The bus driver later drove on a route that included the balloon fiesta park shortly before he ordered the passenger to exit the bus while he inspected under the seats and under the the bus (as if he was checking for car bombs). He was also seen trying to do "donuts" on dry pavement in a USPS truck at 6401 Central at the U-Haul facility that a police officer (that looked like a man that said that he had a Nobel Prize in Physics at a Hardees Red Burrito before and officer Sherre (SP?) of the Chicago Stock Exchange (and Panera's bread company) of Wacker and Jackson street). The officer (presumably with a Nobel prize had said that he worked in identify theft insurance and that he worked for the police (when he was at the Hardees red burrito). Assuming that the events previously mentioned in this report will successfully identify me I will continue with a discussion relevant to the fcc of phone calls not going through. The first phone call that didn't go through was from the Office Depot at 5001 Cutler that was supposed to be to the Champaign County police department (a funeral service answered from a different state (as I viewed the correct area code for the Champaign County Sheriffs office and phone number on the LCD readout of the phone). The second phone call that didn't go through was the phone call to the Independence police department from the Bank of America about three or four premissis's east of Ceaser's resturaunt on the North-West corner of San Mateo and Lomas (across Lomas street from Lesman's music store). I was trying to explain a similar incident to one that was occurring yesterday morning next to my room and occurred at two Motel 6's when I talked to an officer Atwood. The officer looked like somebody that would work for the air force and said something about me knowing what I was talking about after I worked a proof to a relativity problem that inventend involving products of infinite numbers of "boosts" with infinitesimal associated velocities. A "Judge" came to the Kinkos next to the Applebees where I had written the proof on a napkin and I informed him of

a video at the Hardees red buritto of four people in a convertible being dropped from a cargo plane (before talking to the officer (with the Nobel prize). While I am on the topic phone calls not being connected to the correct destination I will mention the call to TC (the acting director of licensing division of the Copyright office at the Library of Congress (according to the recording on her answering machine). I had made a call from an lhop at about 3:30 a.m not many days before that on the was to a motel next to quivera were I met with an officer Hyatt and an officer that was with APD officer Lowell. Officer Hyatt had me show him the books inside my back back including a mathematical methods for physicists and chemist recently stolen from the Days in (at 10321 Hotel Circle ? (near Lomas and Eubank)). The news of the space shuttle being moved to New York was a suprising coincidence occurring not long after I bought the book that was written by a professor from Syracuse University in NYC (according to the title page). The phone call from outside of the Uptown branch of the Bank of America (next to ABQ Brew Pub) did not go through to TC but rather to a credit card loss reporting agency as I read license plate numbers while trying to understand what happened to my lost credit card. Officer Hernandez and another officer arrived about four hours after I had called and told me to pick up my belongings and go. Officer Hernandez was the officer that came to the Quality Inn at 75 Hotel Circle about the time of the presidential election and officer Meyer was dispatched to the Econolodge at 75 1/2 hotel circle next to the Quality Inn. I reported that my card "election card" was missing on the day of the election. Officer Meyer may have been a victim of comments in March of 2008 from somebody that said that he wacked off on somebody's underwear, but said that there would definitely be an investigation after reporting that the my voters registration card was missing (or other similar anomalies). One of the two officer ask if I had invited somebody over.
