

I oppose any changes to the FCC indecency standards that would allow television and radio stations to broadcast expletives and nudity on the public airwaves, even if brief or "fleeting."

With support from the Supreme Court making it clear that the FCC has the authority to enforce standards, I see no reason to loosen them any more than has already happened. We risk turning our culture ever more crass and blatant.
