This letter relates to the above-captioned petition by Valley Public Television, Inc. (ValleyPBS), licensee of KVPT-DT, Fresno, California, for a temporary waiver of the June 30, 2012, deadline for Emergency Alert System (EAS) Participants to deploy operational equipment capable of monitoring for, receiving, and processing Common Alerting Protocol (“CAP”) formatted messages.¹ As noted in ValleyPBS’s August 29, 2012, letter responding to the Division’s request for additional information, ValleyPBS has received and installed CAP-compliant equipment, which has been fully operational since August 24, 2012.
