

As the mother of 4 children, ten grandchildren, and ten great-grandchildren (with four more on the way), I deeply oppose any loosening of the current FCC indecency standards that would allow television and radio stations to broadcast expletives and nudity on the public airwaves, however brief or "fleeting." The Supreme Court has confirmed the FCC's authority to enforce policies regarding expletives and nudity, especially during times when children are more likely to be watching or listening to the broadcasts.
