

I oppose any changes to the current FCC indecency standards that would allow television and radio stations to broadcast expletives and nudity on the public airwaves, even if brief or "fleeting."

The Supreme Court has confirmed the FCC's authority to enforce policies regarding expletives and nudity, especially during times when children are likely to be watching or listening. Because shows that air in the non family hour after 9pm to 5am, are often syndicated and reruns air during the family hour (6am - 9pm) I urge you to never allow expletives and nudity even if only briefly or "fleeting" because all shows have the potential to air during the family hour.

Relaxing the current policy would not serve the public interest and I urge the FCC to reject all proposals that would allow for the broadcast of expletives and nudity on FCC-licensed stations.
