

I spoke via telephone about the above-referenced proceeding with the following FCC staff: Lyle Elder, Legal Advisor, Chairman Genachowski (April 4); Louis Peraertz, Legal Advisor, Commissioner Clyburn (April 5); Alex Hoehn-Saric, Policy Director, Commissioner Rosenworcel (April 4 and 5); and Matthew Berry, Chief of Staff, Commissioner Pai (April 4 and 5). In each case I discussed the relationship between Sections 716 and 718 of the Communications Act, that Section 716's pass-through provision does not apply to mobile web browsers, and that the Commission should not require mobile web browsers to comply with Section 716's pass-through provision.
