

I was surprised to hear that the FCC is considering relaxing their standards for what is allowed on television and radio stations. I want to make clear that I oppose any reduction in standards such as those that would allow swear words ("expletives") and/or nudity on the public airwaves. It shouldn't matter that it's brief or fleeting - these types of indecency should not be on public television at all.

Thankfully, the Supreme Court has backed up the FCC's authority to enforce these types of policies and I'd like to think that the FCC will take that responsibility seriously and not only set rules, but enforce them quickly.

If you are considering changing the standards, please make them stricter and encourage those that are on public television and radio to show decorum and maturity and eliminate all expletives from their broadcasts.
