

Commissioner Genachowski,

Greetings. I oppose any changes to current FCC indecency standards that would allow television and radio stations to broadcast expletives and nudity on the public airwaves, even if brief or "fleeting".

The Supreme Court has confirmed the FCC's authority to enforce policies regarding expletives and nudity, especially during times when children are likely to be watching or listening. Quite frankly children are now watching into the extended hours and indecency standards should be enforced 24 hours a day.

Relaxing the current standards might be convenient for the agency, but would not serve the public interest. I forcefully urge the FCC to reject all proposals that would allow for the broadcast of personally offensive expletives and nudity on FCC licensed stations.
