Dear Ms. Dortch:

On April 8, 2013, John Murdock, President, and Greg Rogers, Deputy General Counsel, Bandwidth.com, Inc.; Joseph Cavender, Vice President, Federal Regulatory Affairs, Level 3 Communications, LLC; and the undersigned ("CLEC Participants") met with Nick Degani, Legal Adviser, Commissioner Pai.

In the meeting, the CLEC Participants reiterated their opposition to any waiver granting a trial to allow non-carrier providers direct access to numbering resources. They also discussed the due process and Administrative Procedure Act problems inherent with the proposed "waiver/trial." They emphasized that any trial should not run concurrent with a Notice of Proposed Rulemaking ("NPRM"). They urged the Commission to issue an NPRM to provide for balanced public notice and comment on the issues surrounding access to number resources by non-carrier providers.
