

I oppose any and all changes that would relax the current FCC indecency standards and allow television and radio stations to broadcast expletives and nudity on the public airwaves, even if brief or fleeting.?

The Supreme Court has confirmed the FCC's authority to enforce policies regarding expletives and nudity, especially during times when children are likely to be watching or listening. Yet if we are honest, we see and hear increasing evidence of networks snubbing their noses at that authority.

Relaxing the current policy would not serve the public interest and offers no value to programming. I urge the FCC to reject all proposals that would allow for the broadcast of expletives and nudity on FCC-licensed stations and to begin enforcing those standards in place at this time.
