On Wednesday, April 10, 2013, Doug Smith, Chairman of the Board and Chief Executive Officer of LightSquared Subsidiary LLC (“LightSquared”); Jeffrey Carlisle, Executive Vice President for Regulatory Affairs and Public Policy of LightSquared; and the undersigned of Latham & Watkins LLP, outside counsel to LightSquared, had a discussion with the FCC, NTIA, and NOAA representatives listed below, some of whom participated by telephone.

LightSquared reiterated its view that the proposed shared use of 1675-1680 MHz spectrum is feasible, as explained at pp. 10-19 of the Reply Comments of LightSquared filed on January 4, 2013,<sup>1</sup> and also urged expeditious processing of its proposals for this shared use. LightSquared noted its commitment to continue to work with NOAA and other federal agencies to develop parameters for wireless use of the 1675-1680 MHz band that also ensure the continued, uninterrupted nature of NOAA’s mission.
