I am providing a Copy of a recent bank statement – Our average balance is around what you see here. So far in 2013 we have not collected any funding. As you can see our ending balance of \$881.44 for the whole organization. We can barely keep the electric on. Almost all of that money has come from my own pocket.

Our donations have declined over the years. And it has been a really rough time that we are having procuring funding.

Our programming airs on various Public Access cable systems and channels mainly in the Chicagoland areas. The various TV stations that we air on do not allow us to solicit funding of any sorts on air, nor do they provide us with resources for Close Captioning, It is Public Access TV that does not have CC.

Since we are not allowed to have commercial content – we have a hard time getting sponsors for anything related to this programming.

At this time the Close Captioning requirement would put an undue burden on us financially for these reasons. The average price I have been able to find is around \$300.00 - per 30 min of programming to Close Caption.

When originally applying for the exemption it was an extra thing that we had done. We were hoping to air on other broadcasts, etc. Also the stations were to provide that service if needed. Our organization is struggling so much financially. We have lost most of what we had in the past due to relocation of some past donors.

Please accept this updated information for exemption.

Worldwin Media, NFP 501C(3) Non-for profit – organization continues to produce informative, entertaining, family orientated public access programming.

Our programming airs on various cable systems and channels mainly in the Chicagoland areas. The various TV stations that we air on do not allow us to solicit funding of any sorts on air, nor do they provide us with resources for Close Captioning, It is basically Public Access TV.

Since we are not allowed to have commercial content – we have a hard time getting sponsors for anything related to this programming.

At this time the Close Captioning requirement would put an undue burden on us financially for these reasons. The average price I have been able to find is around \$300.00 - per 30 min of programming to Close Caption.

In 2011 we have grossed only \$4,535.00. So far in 2012, it has been a very rough start – we have only grossed \$2,000.00. Our resources are minimal due to our programming format limitations, and presently the overhead costs are not even met. We cannot pay salaries or anything to our minimal volunteer staff. With the limited funds we have at this time, it would not even cover the cost to contract someone to Close Caption these programs. Also we do not have the funds to purchase Close Captioning equipment.

To Close Caption our 30 min. programs, with approximately twenty-six programs per year, would cost us an additional \$7,800.00 per year. Due to this overwhelming expense, complying with this rule would force us to terminate, and no longer be able to function as an organization.

Please accept this updated petition for exemption for undue burden, section (47 C.F.R. 79.1) of the commission's rules requiring Close Captioning.
