I am the father of three daughters. I already monitor very closely what my children see on TV. If the FCC makes nudity and profanity allowable on broadcast stations, I will limit even more what stations are viewed in our home, if any.

We enjoy watching TV and would like to have more choices that we can enjoy as a family with content that is appropriate for all ages.

I oppose any changes to the current FCC indecency standards that would allow television and radio stations to broadcast expletives and nudity on the public airwaves, even if brief or "fleeting."

The Supreme Court has confirmed the FCC's authority to enforce policies regarding expletives and nudity, especially during times when children are likely to be watching or listening.

Relaxing the current policy would make it possible for my young daughters to see and hear things that I don't believe are appropriate for them. I urge the FCC to reject all proposals that would allow for the broadcast of expletives and nudity on FCC-licensed stations.
