Mr. Dougherty,

We are in receipt of your second request for an extension of time filed on behalf of your client, Western Pacific Broadcast LLC, Inc., licensee of station WACP, on January 28, 2013, and requesting permission to file your reply to the opposition of Armstrong Utilities, Inc., by February 18, 2013. You again note in your request that the engineers of the respective parties are exchanging information, that delaying to see the outcome of these discussions may result in this matter being informally resolved, that this extension is of very short duration, and that such delay would not harm the interests of Armstrong. You also state that Armstrong is aware of your request for an extension and will not interpose an objection to this motion. Accordingly we will grant this Motion for Extension of Time, allowing you until February 18, 2013, to file your reply, and we note that the 120 day statutory period that applies to such petitions for special relief will be tolled during this time.
