My name is Kevin McGeary. I am over the age of 18 and competent to provide this affidavit. I hereby swear and affirm under the penalties of perjury that the following is true:


1. I live at 121 Springtree Drive, Newtown Square, PA. My job title is Vice-President. I am an Officer of Line Systems, Inc. ("LSI").
2. I have personal knowledge of the facts set forth herein.
3. I was involved in the access charge dispute and litigation involving the complaint by LSI against Sprint Nextel in the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Pennsylvania ("LSI Federal Court Complaint").
