In accordance with Section 1.1206 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 1.1206, we hereby provide you with notice of an oral ex parte presentation in connection with the above-captioned proceedings. On April 16, 2013, undersigned counsel, on behalf of Smith Bagley, Inc. d/b/a CellularOne ("SBI") met with Irene Flannery and Beau Finley of the Office of Native Affairs and Policy and with Margaret Wiener, William Huber and Patricia Robbins of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau, to discuss the upcoming Phase I Tribal Mobility Fund auction.

In our meeting, we discussed SBI's track record as an Eligible Telecommunications Carrier on Tribal lands in Arizona, New Mexico and Utah, and its progress bringing critical telecommunications service to communities in those areas with the use of high-cost universal service support. We also discussed the list of potentially eligible census blocks for the Phase I Tribal Mobility Fund auction and the Commission's blanket exclusion of census blocks based on Broadband Technology Opportunity Program ("BTOP") commitments, including on underserved tribal lands.
