

I extremely oppose any changes to the current FCC indecency standards that would allow television and radio stations to broadcast expletives and nudity on the public airwaves, even if brief or "fleeting." Allowing more nudity and expletives only serves to further demean and hurt women and children and should not be allowed to happen.

The Supreme Court has confirmed the FCC's authority to enforce policies regarding expletives and nudity, especially during times when children are likely to be watching or listening. Please continue to use this authority to guard our children wisely.
