Notification of TVC Albany, Inc. pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 64.1120(e)

Dear Ms. Dortch:

On behalf of TVC Albany, Inc. ("TVC") and pursuant to Section 64.1120(e) of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. § 64.1120(e), this letters notifies the Commission of TVC's intent to acquire the domestic interstate customer base and certain other assets of TelJet Longhaul, LLC ("TelJet"). A Joint Application for Commission approval of the transfer of TelJet's domestic interstate telecommunications assets was filed on April 8, 2013 (WC Docket 13-96).

Names of the Parties to the Transaction: The parties to the transaction are: TelJet Longhaul, LLC, transferor, and TVC Albany, Inc., transferee.

Types of Telecommunications Services Provided to Affected Customers: The customers being transferred from TelJet to TVC are primarily business and enterprise customers. These customers receive data services including Ethernet private line service and dedicated Internet Protocol ("IP") services. Affected customers are located in Vermont and New Hampshire.

Date of the Transfer: The planned transfer of TelJet's customers to TVC will take place following the approval of the Joint Application pending before the Commission and receipt of certain other required approvals. The Parties estimate that the transfer will take place on or after May 31, 2013.

Certification of Compliance: Attached hereto as Attachment A is a certification from TVC required under Section 64.1120(e)(1) of the Commission's rules.

Copy of Notice Sent to Affected Subscribers: Attached hereto as Attachment B is a copy of the form of customer notice that was mailed to affected customers on April 26, 2013. We note that TelJet does not provide any presubscribed voice
