

I should be able to choose if I want to expose myself or my family to foul language and/or nudity not have it streamed into my home over public channels. I currently only use an antenna for television viewing but will be disconnecting it if foul language and nudity are broadcast. I oppose any changes to the current FCC indecency standards that would allow television and radio stations to broadcast expletives and nudity on the public airwaves, even if brief or "fleeting."

The Supreme Court has confirmed the FCC's authority to enforce policies regarding expletives and nudity, especially during times when children are likely to be watching or listening.

Relaxing the current policy would not serve the public interest and I urge the FCC to reject all proposals that would allow for the broadcast of expletives and nudity on FCC-licensed stations. Please hold to the current standards and provide individuals and families the right to choose what they want to watch instead of having it streamed over public networks.
