My location is charlotte county virginia. There is NO DSL service in my area. NONE.

In response to centurylink's filing posted april 30,2013. I generally support their april 30 2013 submission. As a consumer of centurylink's landline phone service. A seamless continuation of expansion of DSL broadband service seem to be the efficient way to build. Of course if centurylink had accepted previous funding,more build out to uneconomic areas would have been made. Sometimes ethics should trump corporate profit motivation.

In my area there are high cost cellular options at \$10.00 an additional GB or perhaps high cost satellite opportunities with low data caps. But these services are both ineffective and unaffordable depending on liberal use of modern entertainment devices combined with other internet usage.

So in sum,i support centurylink's recent filing,in so far as bringing broadband to unserved areas completely lacking 3 Mbps/786 Kbps broadband.

After all government budgets are strained,therefore WASTEFUL spending on adequately served areas is contrary to fiscal responsibility. With that being said,i asked the commission to adopt an appropriate order releasing the remaining Connect America Fund (CAF) Phase I funds.
