
Dear Ms. Dortch:

In accordance with Section 1.1206 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 1.1206, this letter notifies the Commission that on April 30, 2013, Susan Crandall, Assistant General Counsel, Intelsat Corporation, and Gregg Elias and the undersigned of Wiley Rein LLP, counsel for Intelsat, met with Dave Grimaldi and Louis Peraertz, advisors to Commissioner Clyburn, to discuss the above-referenced proceeding proposing to reform the Commission's policies and procedures for assessing and collecting regulatory fees.¹

In the meeting, Intelsat explained its concerns with aspects of the regulatory fee proposal detailed in the *Notice*. Intelsat reiterated the arguments set forth in its reply comments and in its February 22, 2013 letter.² In particular, Intelsat emphasized that there is no rational basis for tripling the already extremely high annual regulatory fees paid by satellite licensees.
