

911 outage prevention Audit --- has unveiled a plethora of dilemma's

The problem of no access to site was once resolved by Verizon paying for parking garage spaces in adjacent garage for locations. They over time reduced them to only 1 spot for a manager so he doesn't have to pay to come to work and another for only one associate car which is reality has transformed into a different function from what it was derived for in first place since the manager and technician have a function for frame orders for new installs to hook up new customers for new services in the central office so as the managers indexes look nicer for team award incentives to be better met and none for the people coming into the city from the remote other locations that do work on the common equipment for processing call traffic itself and e911 calls and access the sites equipment rooms etc.... The site also is missing the expensive micro wave radio that served as an emergency back up system linking the site to the FX lines to all the other buildings via the phone with mult fx lines to it's close by end offices and to the maintenance garages , technical support and the E911 center. The e911 Center had a microwave radio and the site and the maintenance garages. The site still has a micro wave antenna on the roof for it but the radio is gone.

The radio used to ring like a telephone and interact with the Verizon wireless cell phone towers by rotating a dial and selecting the tower you wanted thus it could skip over areas out of service by a fiberoptic cable cut outage and t3 outage and work as a tool to restore service by providing end to end communication with the various other counter parts in the network with radios alike.

They once had more parking spaces left open for workers to respond an outage in the facility for vehicles arriving onto the site to park in , then whats there now and no they were not for managers and people with other things.

Hopefully your audit detects and identifies and rectifies all, indiscreetly
