WiFi and Other Wireless Devices/Transmitters-We are The Experiment-The Research

Due to a lack of adequate FCC guidelines limiting exposure of children to RF radiation emitted from wireless, we are now moving this harmful technology into our schools to the detriment of the health and well being of our children.

In May 2011, The World Health Organization reclassified electromagnetic fields as used by WiFi as possibly carcinogenic. If it is possibly carcinogenic, why are we exposing our staff and our most vulnerable children to it all day everyday? Our school board in its own resolution in May 2009 recommended “responsible deployment of fiber optic broadband technology, which is superior to wireless technology in speed, reliability, security, durability and protections it affords people and the environment from the potential hazards of exposure to radio-frequency radiation..

Now in a drastic change in direction, they are moving from wired to wireless connectivity. In board resolutions in 2000 and 2009 our school board noted that the "National Institutes of Health recently concluded that enough evidence exists to support the classification of electromagnetic fields as a possible human carcinogen..." and fought to keep cell phone towers and other microwave emitting devices off of campuses and at

least 200 feet from schools; now they are moving these same microwave emitting devices inside our schools in close proximity to our staff and children?

The fact is the FCC guidelines which are suppose to ensure our safety are not safety standards at all and are simply guidelines which only take into account thermal effects of microwave exposure not non-thermal effects even though studies have shown harmful biological effects including cancer, cardiac and immune system disorders. In 2009, in their own resolution LAUSD school board stated that "there continues to be considerable debate as to the adequacy of existing public exposure standards including those promulgated by the Federal Communications Commission..."

Women absorb more microwave radiation energy and thus are more negatively effected than men due to greater water content in their bodies where microwaves focus as are people of smaller stature. The FCC guidelines are designed for a 220lb 6ft male and do not account for special populations such as children, pregnant women or people of smaller stature. The FCC guidelines only address 30 minutes of exposure and were adopted from microwave ovens and do not apply to the continuous exposure of WiFi.

Just ask Steve Jobs, Johnnie Cochran, Senator Edward Kennedy, Gary Carter and most recently Steve Sabol from NFL films if wireless technology is safe. Ask Sheryl Crow and Lebron James who recently had tumors removed from their brain and face where they held their phones. It is important to look at these anecdotal stories because without enough studies being done to establish safety standards, we are the experiment-the research as large groups of us are microwaved daily.

Should you be alarmed-yes. Better to be alarmed now and do something to stop implementation at your school and in your community than be alarmed when one of your young staff members or children develop cancer after years of exposure. How can we avoid all of this risky exposure to harmful microwaves used in WiFi and other wireless devices, simply by going wired rather than wireless for our internet access and thereby send the microwave energy through insulated wires rather than through our children and staff and friends.

How many more people have to suffer and die before we wake up to the dangers of microwave radiation from wireless?
