**Re: Notice of Oral Ex Parte Presentation  
WT Docket No. 11-49  
ET Docket No. 13-49**

Dear Ms. Dortch:

The Wireless Internet Service Providers Association (“WISPA”), by counsel, hereby provides notice that, on May 9, 2013, certain of its members and undersigned counsel met with Rashmi Doshi, Matthew Hussey and Ron Repasi of the Commission’s Office of Engineering and Technology (“OET”).<sup>1</sup> The meeting consisted of a presentation by the three OET staff members followed by a discussion of certain issues. Bruce Romano of OET was in attendance at the event.

With respect to WT Docket No. 11-49, OET staff explained that it was working on issues related to the extent to which operation of the Progeny LMS, LLC system would cause “unacceptable levels of interference” to Part 15 devices. All of the WISPA members in attendance indicated that a 50 percent reduction in throughput would be “unacceptable,” and one member stated that such a throughput loss would affect as much as one-third of his company’s customers.

With respect to ET Docket No. 13-49, OET staff thanked WISPA for helping to establish a voluntary database as part of governmental efforts to eliminate harmful interference to Terminal Doppler Weather Radio facilities. WISPA members questioned the Commission’s proposal in the Notice of Proposed Rulemaking that could, if adopted, require equipment changes to enable continued operation in the U-NII-3 (5725-5825 MHz) band. WISPA’s counsel indicated that WISPA likely would be addressing this issue in its Comments. The WISPA

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members also raised questions about the rules for dynamic frequency selection (“DFS”) that sometimes create “false positives” in detection of non-radar systems. OET staff suggested that WISPA and its members may wish to make a proposal on how the DFS requirements might be improved.
