

Robocalls are getting worse. A possible way of stopping them is to have a dial sequence during or right after a call that will tag a phone number (not what is on Caller ID, but the actual number). If there are sufficient tags in a short period of time, the phone company will suspend service to that phone number. Phone numbers need to be registered to a person that will be held legally responsible for this (appeals can overturn if can prove to a court that it was not breaking laws). Overseas numbers that cannot be blocked or traced to a person could be submitted to all phone companies and the phone companies can block all calls from those numbers. (technology to turn off numbers has been around 25 years - a prank caller - prior to Caller ID - to a business had a phone line turned off for harassment with this technology - needed to contact the phone company to turn it back on)
