

We vehemently oppose the proposed changes to the FCC decency standards. The Federal Communications Commission has been responsible for the enforcement of policies prohibiting indecent acts/behaviors (nudity, lascivious behavior, expletives, etc.) on the public airwaves... even those of a brief or fleeting nature. I would request that you maintain the standard as it currently stands and not allow the public airwaves to devolve to the same level that "for pay" television (such as cable or internet) allow.

It is our understanding that the Supreme Court has confirmed the authority of the FCC to enforce these community decency standards especially during times when children are more likely to be watching or listening to the programming.

We would stand with those who believe that it would be against the public interest to allow for the relaxing of the current standards on FCC licensed stations. Please refrain from changing the guidelines as they now stand.
