Pursuant to Section 1.1206 of the Commission Rules, this notice of an ex parte presentation in the above-referenced matters is being provided. On May 14, 2013, Ben Downs, Vice President and General Manager of Bryan Broadcasting Corporation, had a meeting at the FCC with Peter Doyle, Chief of the Audio Division of the Media Bureau; Tom Hutton, Deputy Chief, Legal; James Bradshaw, Deputy Chief, Engineering; Susan Crawford, Assistant Division Chief; and Thomas Nessinger, Senior Counsel.

The discussion included the following:

- Role of translators in AM revitalization including approval of the Tell City Waiver and the one-per-AM translator filing window.
- Opportunity to enter agreements with licensees of LPFM stations for use by AM station licensees.
- Modification of skywave protection to allow the nearly 900 stations with zero to 25 watts of night power to operate full time.
- Advantages of full digital AM operation and the analog sunset.
- Results of Texas Association of Broadcasters Survey of AM Licensees regarding availability and prices for translators in local markets.
