
**Memorandum Opinion and Order in Time Warner Cable Inc.

Dear Ms. Dortch:

On behalf of Time Warner Cable Inc., as a follow up to our April 1, 2013 and May 24, 2013 letters, and in reference to the above-captioned effective competition petitions and order, this is to confirm the proper CUIDs for the following four communities: Village of Centerville - OH3047, the City of Waverly - OH0128, Groton Township - OH2981 and Webster Township - OH3033. As discussed in the earlier letters, each of these communities has already been determined to be subject to effective competition in DA 11-491, but the caption and exhibit in that order improperly lists the CUIDs for each. We therefore request that the Media Bureau issue appropriate clarifications to reflect the earlier grant and the association of the correct CUIDs.
