My name is James L Teel. I am a resident of Winter Park, Florida. I am an unsecured creditor who is owed \$320,000 in the Maritime Communications/Land Mobile, LLC ("MC/LM") Bankruptcy. I have obviously had a great deal of interest in the bankruptcy case. I voted as a creditor for the Plan of Reorganization, and wish to comment on the Second Thursday application of MC/LM and Choctaw Holdings, LLC.

This whole Bankruptcy Process has taken much longer than I had expected. As a retired individual, the money owed to me is of great importance to my wife and I. I have, frequently talked with the Choctaw group to try to understand the Plan of Reorganization and Second Thursday filing. Through these conversations I have found that the Choctaw Group has put up over \$2,000,000 in order to protect the value of the assets for the creditors

and the estate. Without their significant level of support, I do not believe the opportunity would exist today to repay any of the creditors. They should be commended for their efforts to risk their money and spend their time to bring this matter to a satisfactory conclusion.

Through past experience I know that the FCC licenses in question are of significant value. I also know that there are contracts in place, which, if a quick Second Thursday ruling is forthcoming, will put those licenses to good use. By doing so, the sales of those licenses will begin the process of repaying creditors like myself. I am certain the Choctaw Group will handle all of these matters in a responsible manner.

I strongly encourage the Federal Communications Commission to act quickly to grant the applications filed by Choctaw Holdings, LLC in accordance with the Second Thursday doctrine.
