Dear Ms. Dortch:

On May 30, 2013, Krista Witanowski, Assistant Vice President, Regulatory Affairs, CTIA-The Wireless Association®, met with Louis Peraertz, Legal Advisor for Wireless, International, and Public Safety issues, Office of Acting Chairwoman Mignon Clyburn, and separately had a phone conversation with, Jennifer Tatel, Office of General Counsel, to discuss the Commission's proceeding on privacy and security of information stored on mobile communications devices, ("CPNI proceeding").

At the meeting, we discussed the status and timing of the Commission's proposal on circulation to issue a declaratory ruling addressing how the CPNI requirements apply to information stored on mobile communications devices. The FCC did acknowledge the value of using diagnostic applications such as Carrier IQ and collecting such information to improve network performance and that the FCC had no intention of restricting carriers from continuing to do so.
