On Friday, May 31, 2013, the undersigned authored separate emails to Matthew Berry, Alex Hoehn-Saric, and David Grimaldi of the commissioners' staffs about scheduling meetings with their respective commissioners. We proposed commissioner meetings with three of this firm's clients who have interests in modification of the newspaper/radio cross ownership rule. In these scheduling messages, it was stated that our clients want to urge repeal of the cross ownership ban based on their experience as newspaper and radio station owners in different parts of the country, and on the conclusion of the Minority Media and Telecommunications Council's recent study that repeal will have no impact on minority or female ownership of radio. It also was stated that our three clients would like to discuss how the rule is damaging to local newspapers and is an impediment to competition and news dissemination.
