

I cannot understand why it is so necessary to relax indecency standards on broadcast television when there are plenty of other means (e.g., cable, video streaming, pay-per-view, etc.) available for those who, for whatever reason, feel they must listen to vulgar dialogue.

Please give those of us who do not wish to be exposed to filthy language a choice for vulgar-free entertainment without having to worry about f-bombs, nudity, or other lewd programming, regardless of how "fleeting" it may be.
