

The Federal Communications Commission (FCC) is responsible for enforcing decency standards on broadcast TV. These standards prohibit nudity and profanity on public TV.

Broadcasters do not have a right to turn network television into a cesspool at the expense of children and those who wish to avoid the foul language and pornography that is now so common on cable television.

Do not allow network television and local radio stations to air the f-word, the s-word and to allow programs to show frontal female nudity.
