It used to be that certain parts of the human body were referred to as "private parts" and everyone understood that those parts of the body were supposed to be clothed and kept private. Or could it be that they are intentionally trying to corrupt our youth and destroy the future character of the nation? In either case, I will end with this sober warning of Jesus regarding those who corrupt youth:
