Dear Ms. Dortch:

Pursuant to Section 1.1206 of the Commission's rules, the undersigned counsel hereby provides notice that on June 4, 2013, Intrado Inc. ("Intrado") met with members of the FCC's Technology Transitions Policy Task Force concerning its Public Notice seeking comment on potential real-world trials relating to the on-going transition of telecommunications networks.¹ In attendance on behalf of Intrado were Stephen Meer, Chief Technology Officer, Intrado Inc., and the undersigned. The following FCC personnel attended the meeting: Sean Lev, Patrick Halley, Steve Wildman, David Turetsky, David Furth, Jonathan Chambers, Nicole McGinnis, Tim May and Lauren McCarty.

Intrado discussed the proposed Public Safety – NG911 trial discussed in the Public Notice. Intrado discussed the potential design of such trials, noting that any trial will involve not just NG911 technology but also compatibility with legacy 911 systems and technologies. Intrado stated that trials should capture data on technical, regulatory and



operational aspects of NG911 deployments, and recommended that the Task Force design trials in greenfield locations with varied geographic, economic and competitive characteristics to the extent possible. Intrado also discussed how trials may assist the Commission (and the industry) to identify and define practices and responsibilities for each entity participating in an NG911 call, including the identification of entities that should be considered 911 service providers for regulatory purposes and the determination of requirements to ensure the resiliency of NG911 networks. Intrado answered questions from the Task Force concerning data collection metrics applicable to trials, the availability of participants for trials and the scope of FCC authority to facilitate trials.

In accordance with Section 1.1206(b)(2)(iii), this notice is timely filed.
