

I implore you to take a hard, firm stance that will let the script writers know that they are wasting their time if they include inappropriate material in prime time TV so they can focus on providing us, in our homes, with good, decent entertainment that we don't have to shield our children from.

Therefore, I oppose any changes to the current FCC indecency standards. The FCC must continue to vigorously oppose ALL indecent content, even if brief or "fleeting."

The Supreme Court has affirmed the FCC's authority to enforce policies prohibiting indecent broadcast content during hours when children are likely to be in the viewing or listening audience.

Relaxing the current policy would not serve the public interest and I urge the FCC to reject all proposals that would allow for the broadcast of expletives and nudity on FCC-licensed stations.
