

I oppose any changes to the current FCC indecency standards. The FCC must continue to vigorously oppose ALL indecent content, even if brief or "fleeting."

The Supreme Court affirms the FCC's authority to enforce policies prohibiting indecent broadcast content during hours when children are likely to be in the viewing or listening audience.

Considerations to relax the current policy are outside the public interest and I urge the FCC to reject all proposals to allow for the broadcast of expletives and nudity on FCC-licensed stations. Even when said nudity is "pixilated" or "blurred".
