**NOTICE OF EX PARTE FOR CLARIFICATION
BY THE PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION OF UTAH
AT THE REQUEST OF FCC STAFF**

Report of a June 6, 2013, Ex Parte Communication and Clarification Conversation of the Public Service Commission of Utah's (PSC) technical staff member Dr. John S. Harvey, initiated by the FCC's staff members Jonathan Lechter and Michelle Schaefer.

During the conversation Dr. Harvey clarified that the PSC supported the United States Telecom Association (USTA) waiver petition to waive the requirement that wireline eligible telecommunication carriers (ETCs) must keep the completed customer enrollment documents for each customer on hand. The PSC is unable to develop and put in place secure procedures to move the documents out to the individual carriers on short notice.

The PSC is currently involved in a rule making proceeding to determine the final design of the PSC's involvement with the administration of both the federal and state lifeline programs. While that rule making is on-going the PSC believes it is in the public interest to keep the enrollment documents in their present location. At the conclusion of the rule making proceeding the PSC will either move the wireline customer enrollment documents to the individual carriers or petition the FCC to accept other arrangements which the PSC may develop during the rule making proceeding.

The PSC requests the FCC to grant both the USTA Waiver Petition and its own Waiver petition regarding this matter.
