On June 13, 2013, James Arden Barnett, Jr. and Frederick M. Joyce of the law firm Venable LLP, attorneys representing TruePosition, Inc., a member of the Find Me 911 Coalition, met with members of the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) to discuss the Find Me 911 Coalition and its efforts to encourage the FCC to adopt rules extending location accuracy for wireless 9-1-1 calls originating indoors as a matter of public safety. Members of the FCC present in the meeting were:

Mr. David Turetsky, Chief of the Public Safety and Homeland Security Bureau (PSHSB)
Mr. David Furth, Deputy Bureau Chief of the PSHSB
Mr. Timothy May, Communications Specialist and Project Manager for Next Generation 9-1-1

Specifically, meeting attendees discussed the need for specific data and proposals for indoor location accuracy. This included a discussion of ways of validating and testing indoor location accuracy. The group explored how technology may develop to provide even greater accuracy, including integration with smart building technology and z-axis technologies.

Chief Turetsky, Mr. Furth and Mr. May were provided with the attached documents providing further information on the Find Me 911 Coalition and its members. The documents contain a sampling of comments from members of the coalition regarding the critical importance of 9-1-1 location accuracy to public safety and the ability of first responders to save lives. Additionally, Mr. Furth, Chief Turetsky and Mr. May were presented with a letter sent to Chairman Genachowski from the Major Cities Chiefs Association on May 27, 2013 asking the FCC to adopt requirements that will result in the improvement of indoor location accuracy for emergency calls placed from cellular phones.
