Dear Ms. Dortch:

On June 13, 2013, Christopher Guttman-McCabe, Vice President, Regulatory Affairs, CTIA-The Wireless Association®, had a telephone conversation with Alex Hoehn-Saric, Policy Director, Office of Commissioner Jessica Rosenworcel, to discuss the Commission's proceeding on privacy and security of information stored on mobile communications devices, ("CPNI proceeding").

We discussed the status of the Commission's proposal on circulation to issue a declaratory ruling addressing how the CPNI requirements apply to information stored on mobile communications devices and how carriers should protect such information. CTIA highlighted that its members take security and privacy seriously and are committed to protecting CPNI that a carrier causes to be stored on mobile communications devices.
