

I am writing to express my opposition to any changes to the current decency enforcement standard of the Federal Communications Commission. I specifically oppose the changes suggested by the FCC in GN Docket No. 13-86 because the Federal television decency law, 18 U. S. C. 1464, on its face prohibits all acts of indecency and profanity on broadcast TV. Thus the proposed changes would violate that law. Those changes would specifically allow indecency and profanity on the publicly owned airwaves at times of day when children can be expected to be in the audience.
