("NABOB") met with Chairwoman Mignon Clyburn and Dorothy Terry and Keenan Adamchak of her staff, and Holly Saurer of the Media Bureau. To discuss the matters referenced above.

In the meeting, I explained that:


1. NABOB will file comments on the recent cross-ownership study which has been filed in the Ownership proceeding:
2. There is still a great deal of information that needs to be supplied to television station licensees in order for them to make educated decisions about participating in the Incentive Spectrum Auction. I noted that noncommercial stations are being approached by potential funding sources with respect to making their frequencies
