Dear Ms. Dortch:

On June 24, Christopher Wiczorek, Senior Corporate Counsel, Government Affairs of T-Mobile U.S., Inc. ("T-Mobile"), spoke by telephone with John S. Leibovitz, Deputy Chief of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau, regarding a roadmap prepared by members of the wireless industry for consideration by NTIA's Commerce Spectrum Management Advisory Committee ("CSMAC").

The roadmap, a copy of which is attached, assesses the entire 1755-1850 MHz band in a manner that considers making the lower band (1755-1780 MHz) available first, but also addresses the rest of the band up to 1850 MHz in order to meet federal agencies' concerns. The plan takes into account the NTIA instructions given to the CSMAC Working Groups, which were directed to consider a plan that lowers the repurposing costs and/or improves or facilitates industry access while protecting federal operations from adverse impact.
