On June 25, 2013, on behalf of NTUA Wireless, LLC (“NTUA Wireless”), Walter Haase, Wade McGill, and Derek Dyson participated in-person, and Seth Lucia participated via conference call, in a meeting with Rebekah Goodheart (Legal Advisor to Acting Chairwoman Clyburn) and Travis Litman (FCC Wireline Competition Bureau) (collectively, “FCC Staff”). NTUA Wireless is majority-owned by the Navajo Tribal Utility Authority, an enterprise of the Navajo Nation.

During the June 25, 2013 meeting, representatives of NTUA Wireless discussed with FCC Staff the history and pending nature of NTUA Wireless' current ETC Application, and NTUA Wireless representatives highlighted to FCC Staff that the delay is affecting the potential timing and availability of certain telecommunications services across the Navajo Nation—an area with a pressing need for expanded access to advanced telecommunications services. NTUA Wireless representatives discussed the continued need for the Federal Communications Commission (“Commission” or “FCC”) to act on NTUA Wireless' ETC Application, which has been pending unopposed before the Commission since March 3, 2011. The FCC Staff discussed the FCC's continued review of the application. The NTUA Wireless representatives reiterated their desire for the FCC to act on NTUA Wireless' pending petition for ETC designation. The participants also discussed the ETC requirements related to the Tribal Mobility Fund Auction 902, which is scheduled for October 24, 2013.
