**Re: GN Docket No. 12-268, *Incentive Auctions***

Dear Ms. Dortch,

On June 27, 2013, I met with John Leibovitz, Deputy Bureau Chief of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau, to discuss matters in the above-captioned docket. During our brief conversation, I summarized positions later articulated in the Free Press reply comments submitted in this docket on June 28, 2013.<sup>1</sup>

In brief, I explained that Free Press does not endorse any specific band plan at this time. Regardless of the band plan it ultimately adopts, however, the Commission should establish a guard band or duplex gap in that plan with a contiguous 20 megahertz for unlicensed use in every market. I also expressed Free Press's concerns with any plan that might allow unrestrained market variation, which could diminish the amount of spectrum available for unlicensed use while potentially decreasing the amount of spectrum available to competitive providers as well.

We file this *ex parte* notice today, pursuant to Section 1.1206(b) of the Commission's rules. If you have any questions regarding this submission, please do not hesitate to contact me.
