Pursuant to Section 1.65 of the Federal Communications Commission's ("Commission") rules, 47 C.F.R. § 1.65, Freeconference.com, Inc. ("Freeconference.com") hereby notifies the Commission of a substantial and significant change in information related to the Section 214 application submitted to the Commission by Freeconference.com and Iotum Inc. on October 24, 2012, supplemented on November 16, 2012, and later amended on April 9, 2013 (the "Application").

On June 27, 2013, Freeconference.com and its subsidiary, Global Conference Partners ("GCP"), each filed a voluntary petition for relief under chapter 7 of the United States Bankruptcy Code, 11 U.S.C. §§ 101-1330 as amended, in the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Central District of California.¹

The transaction described in the Application was consummated on May 15, 2013, pursuant to the Special Temporary Authority granted to the Applicants on February 11, 2013, extended on April 11, 2013, and further extended on June 10, 2013. Consummation of the transaction enabled the continued provision of service without interruption to customers. As such, customers are unaffected by the filing of the bankruptcy petitions.
