This is notify you pursuant to Section 1.1206 of the Commission's Rules that on July 10, 2013 Kim Robert Scovill, Senior Director-Legal Government Affairs of TeleCommunication Systems, Inc. ("TCS"), Brian Josef of CTIA and the undersigned met with Louis Peraertz, Legal Advisor to the Chairwoman Clyburn to discuss the above-referenced TCS Petition for Declaratory Ruling and/or Rulemaking ("TCS Petition").

TCS' representatives explained that it was important the Commission act on the TCS Petition in a timely manner. They noted that both actual and threatened IP lawsuits were beginning to affect the deployment of E911 and that the overall effect of PAE litigation on innovation had become a national concern. Finally, they noted that since the comment period had ended the Commission was now in a position to act.
