Dear Ms. Dortch:

On July 15, 2013, Mark E. Crosby, President and CEO, Enterprise Wireless Alliance (“EWA”) and undersigned counsel for EWA, met with the staff of the Public Safety and Homeland Security Bureau and the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau listed below. The parties discussed the following FCC proceedings:

WT Docket No. 05-62/WT Docket No. 02-55: EWA discussed implementation of the recent Order on Reconsideration in WT Docket No. 05-62 and Sprint Nextel Corporation’s ongoing role in that process. It also requested the status of TA certification of completion of rebanding in additional NPSPAC Regions.

RM-11572: EWA requested the status of a Notice of Proposed Rulemaking in response to EWA’s Petition for Rulemaking proposing rule modifications that would permit the licensing of interstitial, full-power, 12.5 kHz channels in the 800 MHz band. EWA noted that the record in response to the FCC’s request for comment on the Petition confirmed broad land mobile support for the proposed rule change, which would provide additional opportunities for deployment of digital systems in this band.

WP Docket No. 07-100: EWA discussed its involvement on behalf of Critical Infrastructure Industry licensees in the NPSTC activities related to the FCC's proposed modifications to eligible uses of the 4.9 GHz band.


WT Docket No. 99-87: EWA requested an update on the status of FCC enforcement activities related to Part 90 narrowbanding requirement, in particular the audit of systems whose licenses did not reflect compliance with that requirement.

PS Docket No. 13-42: EWA requested a status update regarding implementation of H.R. 3630 as it relates to continued PLMR use of 470-512 MHz (T-Band) spectrum. In particular, the Alliance discussed the operational and business issues its members were experiencing because of the T-Band freeze and urged the FCC to modify certain restrictions.
