On July 19, 2013, Michiel Lötter, Vice President of Engineering at Nextivity, Inc. (“Nextivity”), and Catherine Wang and Jeffrey Strenkowski of Bingham McCutchen LLP, counsel to Nextivity, spoke by telephone with Wireless Telecommunications Bureau (“WTB”) staff Roger Noel, Joyce Jones, Moslem Sawez, and Thomas Struble, and Office of Engineering and Technology (“OET”) staff Rashmi Doshi, Tim Harrington, and Steve Jones. Mr. Lötter discussed Nextivity’s concerns over testing procedures and requirements in new Sections 20.21 (e)(9)(i)(A) (noise limits) and Section 20.21(e)(9)(i)(I) (transmit power off mode) applicable to provider-specific signal booster devices pursuant to the Commission’s order in the above-referenced docket. The attendees also discussed OET’s efforts to develop testing guidelines for consumer signal boosters.
